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SENATOR MATT RECTOR CALLS UPON ISLAND BUSINESSES AND COPORATIONS TO PAY FOR WATER AND SEWAGE SERVICES ON CHAMORRO LAND TRUST LEASES!

“The Chamorro Land Trusts mission of returning land to the people has been severely undermined by the lack of sewage and water provided to the lots,” says Senator Matt Rector. “Land without water is not fit for a family,” he continued. For these reasons, Senator Rector called upon the Guam Water Authority to provide full service to all leased properties held by the Chamorro Land Trust Commission **without charge to Land Trust Commission Lessees**, as stated in his latest bill, “The Water for the People Act.”

“The Water for the People Act empowers the hard working men and women of the Guam Waterworks Authority to provide water and sewage services to every Chamorro Land Trust property at no expense to the lessee. “Any expense associated with these services,” says Rector “will be paid for by businesses and Corporations that have profited from doing business in *I Tano I Chamorro*.”

As stated in the bill, “The Guam Waterworks Authority and only the Guam Waterworks Authority shall be responsible for the necessary infrastructure and maintenance required to supply lands held by the Chamorro Land Trust Commission with the necessary water-supply sewage services for the needs of the lease holders of Chamorro Land Trust Commission Properties.”

Additionally, water and sewage services will be provided in a timely and efficient fashion, a span of time not to exceed 90 days from receiving request for Water supply sewage services from a Chamorro Land Trust lease holder.

The bill explains the consequences if these conditions are not met. "This is the right thing to do," concludes Rector.
