1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** Guam functions and succeeds as a result of the hard work
4 of all our working class heroes that serve our island everyday as workers, as
5 parents, as children, as friends, and as active citizens in our democracy; and

6 **WHEREAS,** Guam's working class heroes have long been the forgotten
7 backbone of our island, and they should be recognized for their commitment
8 and loyalty in serving the community; and

9 **WHEREAS,** there would be no tourism industry without hotel workers,
10 no schools without education professionals, no healthcare without nurses, no
11 stores without clerks, no phones without lines people, no clean streets without
12 solid waste professionals, no safe beaches and pools without lifeguards and
13 park rangers, no safety and protection without police officers and firefighters,
14 no restaurants without servers or cooks, no balanced books without
15 accountants, no clean water without water workers, no clean and maintained
16 schools and buildings without custodians and maintenance workers, and no
17 children at school without bus drivers. Guam thrives thanks to our working
18 class heroes; and

19 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Raymond Guerrero has served over ten (10) years in
20 the private sector, inclusive of military and civilian work, contributing
21 valuable knowledge and skills to Guam's working economy; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Raymond Guerrero worked for No Ka Oi as a Sentricon
2 Specialist III, serving the company for five (5) years. Mr. Raymond Guerrero
3 also worked as a subcontractor for the Navy as a Material Handler, and for
4 the Air Force as a Demil Technician for three (3) years, handling explosives
5 and heavy equipment. Mr. Raymond Guerrero is one of the few citizens on
6 island to hold a Marine Radio Operator license; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Raymond Guerrero is currently a lineman for GTA
8 Teleguam, one of Guam’s communications providers, for over two (2) years.
9 Mr. Raymond Guerrero has shown interest in growth within the company by
10 taking the company’s “Learn and Earn” program and further expanding his
11 skills through an apprenticeship program at the Guam Community College
12 for a Journeyman Certificate in the Lineman Installation and Repair field,
13 which will be completed in about three (3) years; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Raymond Guerrero has dedicated close to fifteen (15)
15 years serving as a coach in the Guam Little League Baseball, the Guam Babe
16 Ruth League, as well as the Adult Baseball League. Mr. Raymond Guerrero
17 had the privilege of coaching the Guam All-Star teams at tournaments in
18 Tinian for the World Series Tournament, and at the Babe Ruth Regional
19 Tournament in the United States; and


20 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Raymond Guerrero actively participated in the
21 American Cancer Society’s Relay for Life event as the Team Captain for Na Ko
22 Oi in 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2006, and has devoted some of his time serving as a

1 Municipal Planning Council Member for the Asan/Maina community,
2 addressing issues and concerns within the village; now, therefore, be it

3 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
4 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
5 people of Guam, recognize Raymond Guerrero, one of Guam's working class
6 heroes, for his hard work and dedication, not just to his job, but to all the
7 people of Guam, and does extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to Mr.
8 Guerrero for his leadership and accomplishments; and be it further

9 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on
10 Rules certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and
11 that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Raymond P. Guerrero; and
12 to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.
